

## Golden Sheaf Recreational Development Association General Park Policies

### Park Policy:

1. All park guests must register at the gate house upon arrival. All visitors of guests must be registered with the park gatehouse upon arrival.
2. Campers and guests with adolescents under 18 years of age are responsible for their conduct.
3. Speed limit is 15km/hour.
4. **THERE IS NO LIFE GUARD ON DUTY** at the swimming area. Swim at your own risk.
5. Quiet hours are from 11:00pm - 7:00am. No amplified music at any time. No loud noises at campsites after 11:00pm. Guests visiting campers on a Day Pass must vacate the park by 10:00pm. No exceptions. Please be considerate of your neighbours.
6. Check-out time is 11:00am. Please re-register at the gate house by 10:00am if you want to extend your stay. If you wish to stay beyond the check-out time, the fee is \$5.00 per vehicle,(provided the site is not booked), until 2:00pm, full day rates apply.
7. Only holders of a valid driver's license are permitted to operate a vehicle of any kind on park property.
8. No ATV's shall be operated within the park.
9. Day campers who intend to bring golf carts into the park, must provide proof of insurance at the gate house upon entry to the park.
10. The use of drones within the park is prohibited unless prior written permission is obtained from Park Manager and Transport Canada.
11. Camping units must be located within the boundaries of the camp site; and may not be parked crossways in a non-seasonal campsite.
12. Golden Sheaf Park is not responsible for personal property.
13. Fire pits are available at all sites and firewood is available at the gate house.
14. No alcohol consumption outside of camping sites is permitted.
15. Garbage containers are provided throughout the park.
16. No fireworks, firearms or weapons are allowed.

### Pet Policy:

1. Keep your pets on a leash at all times.
2. Pets are not allowed on the beach or playgrounds.
3. Pets must be under the control of the owners at all times.
4. Control barking.
5. Scoop after your pet.
